

EASTER IS NOT PAGAN Claim: "Easter comes from worship of the Saxon goddess, Eostre or the

Germanic goddess, Ostara."

Truth: There is no evidence that either goddess was actually worshipped. Only the Venerable Bede (600s) and Jacob Grimm mentions them in passing.

Claim: "Easter comes pagan festivals in the spring." Truth: There are multiple festivals in the spring: the Day of Bau (Babylonian), Dark Mother Day (Indian), the Feast of Artemis/Diana (Greek/Roman), the Festival of Ishtar (Babylonian), Odin's Day What's wrong (Norse). Celebrating in Springtime doesn't make Easter pagan. with you people?

Fact: Christians started worshipping Jesus on Sunday (Lord's Day) almost immediately (see Acts 20:7, Rev 1), and the timing of the resurrection is connected to Passover. From the beginning it was about the resurrection, not any pagan holiday.

WHY CALL RESURRECTION SUNDAY "EASTER"?

First, many of the romance languages use "Passover" language in reference to the "Feast of Resurrection": Passover: Pâques (French), Pascua (Spanish), and Pascha (Latin) from Pesach (Hebrew). Not everyone calls Resurrection Sunday "Easter."

POSSIBLE ETYMOLOGY OF "EASTER"

- *hebdomada alba* (Latin "white week") > *esostarum* (Old German) > Easter
- *Eosturmonath* (Scandinavian "April" after Eostre) > Easter
 Latin word for "dawn" > Old German word for "east" > Easter

ANSWER: NO ONE KNOWS FOR SURE WHY IT IS CALLED "EASTER."




THE AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE.

GOD'S WORD SAYS THAT JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD. THERE IS NO HIGHER AUTHORITY THAN THIS.

PRESERVING THE GOSPEL

- Only Accept Eyewitnesses (Apostles) Word: NT Scripture had to be written by an apostle or someone writing the account of an apostle (2 Corinthians 11:1-15, 2 Peter 3:16)
- Reject False Gospels: "But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed." -Gal. 1:8
- Letter Confirmation: Paul Signs letters in his own hand, to protect against forgeries (Philemon 1:19, 2 Thessalonians 3:17, Galatians 6:11) and apostles sent letters through known associates to confirm it was their work (1 Cor. 16:17-18, 2 Cor. 8:16-24, Rom. 16:1-2, Eph. 6:21-22, etc.)
- Duplication and Corroboration: Churches Copied and Shared Apostolic Works (Colossians 4:16)
- Citation: The apostolic fathers (1st-2nd Century Christian Leaders) cited the NT letters as Scripture and considered the canon closed when the last apostle died.
 Succession: Churches kept record of apostles and church
- Succession: Churches kept record of apostles and church bishops to confirm their accounts.

CHURCH RECORDS AND THE GOSPEL

"Let nothing be innovated, says he, nothing maintained, except <u>what</u> <u>has been handed down</u>. Whence is that tradition? Whether <u>does it</u> <u>descend from the authority of the Lord and of the Gospel, or does it</u> <u>come from the commands and the epistles of the apostles?</u> For that those things which are written must be done, God witnesses and admonishes."-**Cyprian of Carthage (210-258 AD)**, *Epistle 73*






CHURCH RECORDS AND THE GOSPEL

But if there be any (heresies) which are bold enough to plant themselves in the midst of the apostolic age, that they may thereby seem to have been handed down by the apostles, because they existed in the time of the apostles, we can say: Let them produce the original records of their churches; let them unfold the roll of their bishops, running down in due succession from the beginning in such a manner that [that first bishop of theirs] bishop shall be able to show for his ordainer and predecessor some one of the apostles or of <u>apostolic men</u>,—a man, moreover, who continued stedfast with the apostles. For this is the manner in which the apostolic churches transmit their registers: as the church of Smyrna, which records that Polycarp was placed therein by John; as also the church of Rome, which makes Clement to have been ordained in like manner by Peter. In exactly the same way the other churches likewise exhibit (their several worthies), whom, as having been appointed to their episcopal places by apostles, they regard as transmitters of the apostolic seed. -Tertullian (155 - 240 AD), The Prescription Against Heretics 20, 21 and 32

20 But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. 23 But each in his own order: <u>also in Christ shall all be made alive.</u> 23 But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. 24 Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. 25 For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. 26 <u>The last</u> <u>enemy to be destroyed is death.</u> 27 For "God has put all things in subjection under his feet." But when it says, "all things are put in subjection," it is plain that he is excepted who put all things in subjection under him. 28 When all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to him who put all things in subjection under him, that God may be all in all.

1 CORINTHIANS 15:20-28

50 I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. 51 Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but <u>we shall all be changed</u>, 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. 53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. 54 When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written:
